There are several of those records of recording sessions which are the best of the best and the most interesting of the recordings of the Dave Brubeck Quartet. The Dave Brubeck Quartet is a group of four musicians who have been playing together since 1955. They are Dave Brubeck on piano, Paul Dwyer on bass, Kai Winding on trombone, and Joe Morello on drums. They have recorded several albums for Columbia Records, and their music is a blend of jazz and classical music. This album, recorded at the Newport Jazz Festival in 1958, is a collection of their best work. It includes the Dave Brubeck Quartet's "You Can Drive With Your Eyes Closed," "Take the 'A' Train," and "Take a Tiny Step," as well as the J. J. Johnson-Kai Winding Quintet's "Lover Come Back to Me," "You Blue Train," and "Stage."

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
